- **Symposium Chairs:**

 - 55 papers submitted.
 - **TPC Members and Review Process:**
 - Around 270 members (mix from industry and academia).
 - Each TPC member received at most 3 papers for handling the review process.
 - For each assigned paper, each TPC will be responsible to ensure only ONE review (either by him/herself or delegated to someone else).

- **Remarks:**

- About 70% of the submissions are related to AI, DL, RL topics. Thus, it is apparant that Cognitive Radio and AI-Enabled Networks is a virant research area that has attracted increasingly number of researchers from around the world.
- The authors of selected papers can be invited to submit an extended version of their works for fast-track review and possible publication in IEEE TCCN.
