 - 66 papers submitted to GC2020 CRAEN.
 - 55 submissions for ICC2020, 93 FOR GLOBECOM2019.
 - Reduced submission number for GC2020.
- **TPC Members and Review Process:**
 - 49 members
 - Each TPC member received at most 6 papers for handling the review process.
 - For each assigned paper, each TPC will be responsible to ensure only ONE review (either by him/herself or delegated to someone else).

- **Remarks:**

- Influenced by COVIS-19.
- About 70% of the submissions are related to AI, DL, RL topics.
- The authors of selected papers can be invited to submit an extended version of their works for fast-track review and possible publication in IEEE TCCN. (Can we do this?)
